## Hispanic Unity of Florida Named NCLR Affiliate of the Year

**ORLANDO, Fla.**—<u>Hispanic Unity of Florida (HUF)</u> received the Affiliate of the Year Award this evening at the 2016 NCLR (National Council of La Raza) Annual Conference. The Affiliate of the Year Award is the highest honor bestowed upon an NCLR Affiliate for its exemplary efforts in collaborating with NCLR to achieve positive and meaningful change for Latino communities.

HUF is the largest Hispanic/immigrant-serving nonprofit organization in Broward County, Fla., and is dedicated to a mission of "empowering immigrants and others to become self-sufficient, productive and civically engaged." Founded in 1982, HUF became an NCLR Affiliate in 2007. Since then, it has been an active partner in expanding opportunities for Hispanic Americans in the areas of civic engagement, economic empowerment and workforce development.

HUF has partnered with NCLR on various initiatives, including NCLR's 2016 voter registration campaign, our efforts to end predatory payday lending practices, and the Citizenship Savings and Loans project, which helps eligible legal permanent residents pay for naturalization applications. HUF also recently partnered with NCLR and Affiliate El Barrio in Cleveland to launch a customer service and retail sales training program, and recently secured funding to add a bank teller training program. In the health arena, HUF has also provided its clients with guidance in filling out Affordable Care Act applications, and helped launch a healthy food selection shopping program through the NCLR *Comprando Rico y Sano* grant.

"Hispanic Unity of Florida has been a key partner in so many of our initiatives—from helping to register eligible Latino voters in South Florida to educating our community on healthier eating and getting signed up for health care—they are always looking for new ways to help empower Latinos and place them on a path to reaching their full potential," said Janet Murguía, NCLR President and CEO. "We are proud of our continued partnership with Hispanic Unity and to witness the growth of the organization and its success in providing key services to thousands of Latino families in Florida."

The Affiliate of the Year Award, in collaboration with Ford Motor Company Fund, is the highest honor awarded to an <u>NCLR Affiliate</u> for its outstanding contributions to the Latino community
