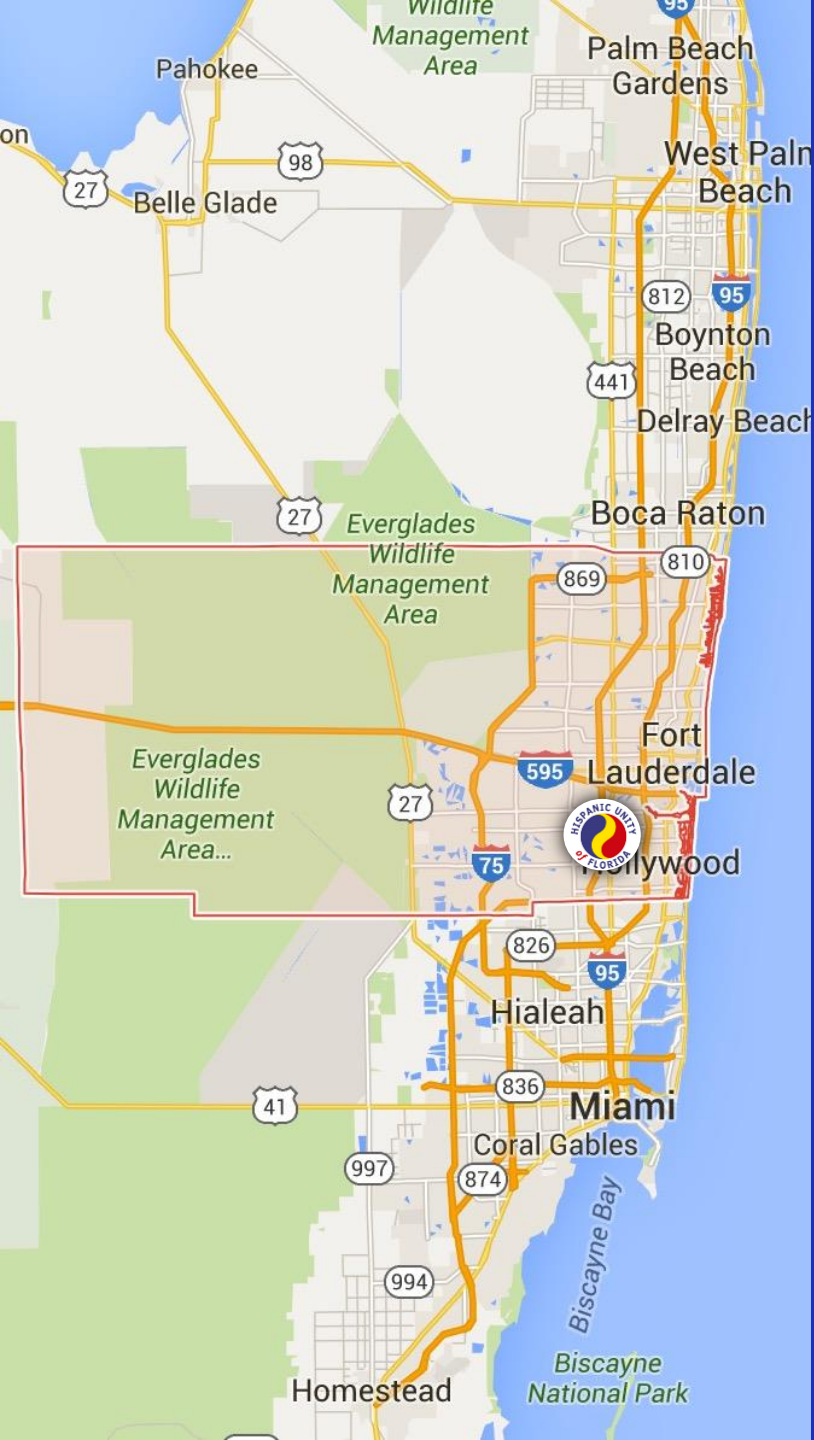

HUF Impact - Client Stories



Hispanic Unity was founded 34 years ago by community leaders to ease the acculturation transition for newcomers from other nations.

We remain the county's largest agency dedicated to the immigrant population, providing the tools needed to build a new life through:

- 12 Programs
- 30+ Services
- 4 Languages

In 2015, the agency served 17,000+ clients, from toddlers to adults.





Civic Engagement

1,401 assisted with U.S. Citizenship and Naturalization

296 of the 1,401 clients attended USCIS' /HUF's Pathways to Citizenship intensive classes

700+ clients became new American Citizens

Legal Assistance

100+ clients received FREE legal services through our partner, Legal Aid Service of Broward County





Economic Development

- 5,513 received FREE tax preparation - economic impact of \$5.74 million in tax refunds to Broward County
- 87% of our Center for Working Families clients reduced debt/improved their credit score
- 271 learned how to start/strengthen their small business
- 300+ attended HUF's 4th Annual Entrepreneur

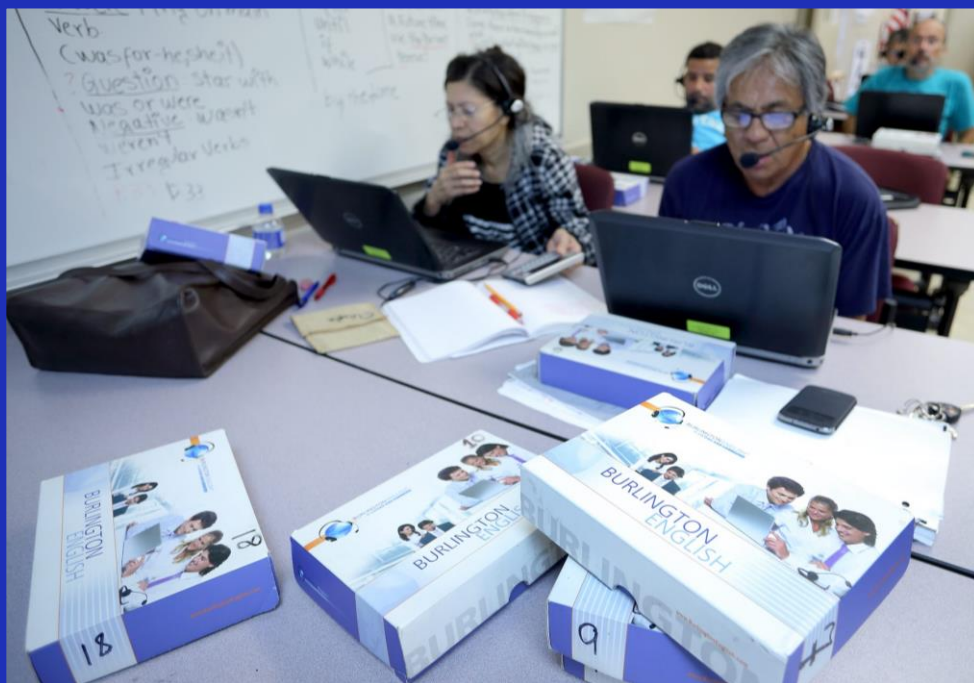

- 100% of preschoolers ready for Kindergarten
- 100% of parents improved communications via classes and parent-teach conferences
- 94% of preschoolers expanded their cognitive skills
- 82% of parents read to their children 5x/Week

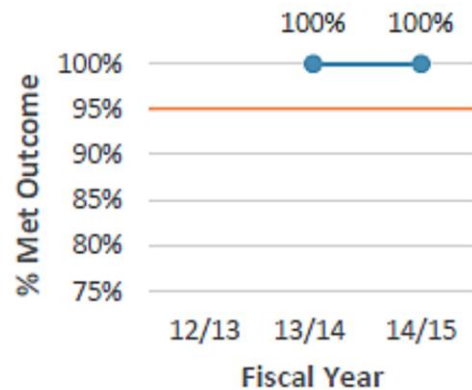

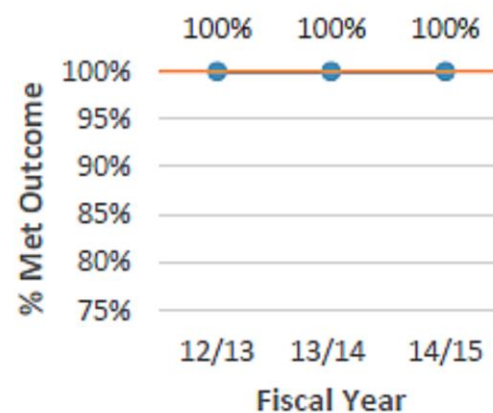
Unity 4Teens Middle Schools

- 408 students (Attucks, Apollo, McNicol, and Olsen Middle schools) received tools for academic and social success
- 100% of students maintained a clean record while enrolled in the program
- 92% of students improved grades/attendance
- 100% did not become pregnant, cause a pregnancy or use alcohol or drugs

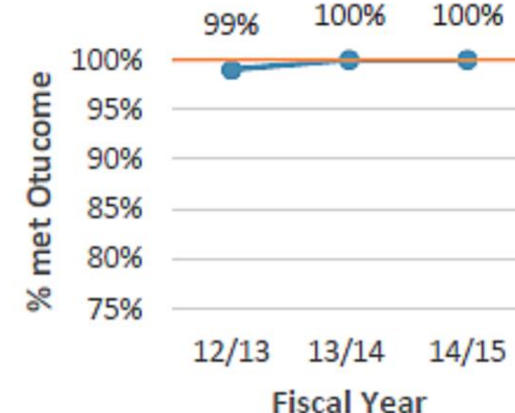
Law Violations

Education

Unity 4Teens High Schools

- Prepared 400 students (Miramar and Stranahan high schools) to become college and career ready
- 100% of high school seniors accepted into college and 33% received \$200K in scholarships
- 86% of youth improved grades & attendance
- 76% of high school seniors passed all four sections of the ACT with college-readiness scores





Health & Family Care

- 1,591 learned how to prepare healthy meals
- 509 clients submitted affordable healthcare applications with an annual savings of \$1,494,609 in healthcare costs
- 247 clients purchased a Qualified Health Plan





Advocacy & Outreach

HUF developed a plan, identified several advocacy efforts and provided staff and Board of Director training and education.
